For the past twelve years, the Mann Art Gallery has presented art by local high school students in the Project and Education Studio Galleries of our beautiful space. This year, during the typical High School Juried Art Show period (April - June), we are determined to showcase and celebrate the artistic achievements and creative vision of talented students through an exhibition!

The Process

All Grade 9 - 12 students in Prince Albert and the surrounding area are invited to participate in this exhibition.

We will temporarily frame, hang and light physical artworks. A website page will also be created to highlight the award winners.

Artworks will be juried for cash prizes which will be presented on the Opening Reception and Awards evening May 3, 2024.

Important Dates!

Artwork Drop off: April 16 - 20

Students can submit 1 artwork to be juried. They must do so by filling in the online submission form on the Mann Art Gallery's High School Juried Art Show website page (scan the QR code with your smartphone). Students will then drop off their artwork at the gallery, or a teacher/representative can do so for them. April 16 - 19 10am - 5pm or April 20 noon - 5pm.

Artwork Pick-Up: June 13 - 20, 10AM - 5PM each day

There will be a 5-day period for artwork pick-up. Gallery hours for each day are 10AM - 5PM. Either the artist, purchaser (if an artwork sold), teacher, or an artist representative can pick up the artwork. Please contact the gallery if other arrangements are needed.

Eligibility

• An eligible artist must be a grade 9 - 12 student that currently attends a public, separate or private high school (or is homeschooled) within Prince Albert or surrounding area.

Artwork Requirements

- Only 1 artwork per student and the artwork must be the artist's own work. If an artwork has more than one component (i.e., a diptych), it is still considered one submission. All mediums are encouraged!
- Artwork must have been produced within the past year in school or outside of school art classes.
- In addition to filling out the online submission form on the Mann Art Gallery's website, each entry of artwork must have attached on the back: the artist's name and school, artwork title, date, size, medium, and sale price (if applicable).
- Jury Selection & Display: The Mann Art Gallery staff will make selections from the submissions to be included in the exhibition. We will ensure that at least 1 work from each school is juried into the exhibition, but are unable to guarantee that each student will have an artwork juried into the show. We will let teachers and students know as soon as possible before the exhibition which artworks will be included in the juried show. We will temporarily frame, hang and light works.
- All physical artwork entries must be delivered and unpacked by the artist or their representative at the Mann Art Gallery on the drop-off dates mentioned previously.

How to Submit your Artwork

Please fill in the Artwork online application form found on the Mann Art Gallery's website, you will need to include the following info for <u>each artwork</u>:

- Title
- Date
- Medium (ex. graphite on paper, acrylic on canvas)
- Size (ex. 11 x 14 in)
- Sale price (if the artwork is for sale)
- School & Grade
